Multi-age Family Storytime

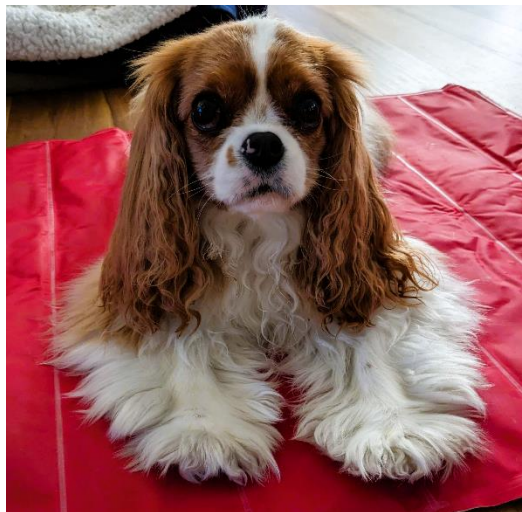
(For ages birth to 5 with an adult caregiver)
