RULES

- Contest is open to South Burlington resident cardholders only. Don't yet have a card? Come in and get one before you submit!
- One entry per contestant.
- All designs must be the creative and original work of a single individual; no copyrighted or AI-generated images will be accepted. Content must be suitable for all ages.
- Artwork can include high resolution computer generated or digital photographic submissions or paper submissions using colored pencil, pen, paint, camera, or computer-generated art. Digital submissions must be in the following file types: JPEG, PNG, or PDF.
- Design must fit card dimensions of 3 ½ inches wide x 2 ¼ inches high. Please also include a brief 1-3 sentence description of the concept behind your design.
- Artwork will be accepted starting on **June 16, 2025**. The deadline for submission is midnight on **August 1, 2025**. Winners will be notified on August 15, and winning artwork will be featured on our cards starting in September 2025, Library Card Signup Month!
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, originality, and overall aesthetic appeal.
