For Grades 5-8

June 1st – August 9th

1. Register at the Kidspace Desk, and get a Summer Reading Activity Packet

2. Read to earn raffle tickets! Each raffle ticket can be entered for prizes. Earn tickets by reading books*, and by attending Library programs. Each book you read (or listen to), and each time you come to a library program, you earn a raffle ticket!

*You can also count minutes! Reading for 20 minutes can also earn a raffle ticket. Write the number of minutes next to the title on your Raffle Ticket.

3. Trade your raffle ticket for a small prize from the treasure chest or drop your raffle ticket into one of the big Prize Buckets of your choice!

4. Prize options for readers in grades 5-8 include several after-hours events at the library. Winners of these prizes must be registered for Summer Reading and over the age of ten.
